INNOVATION UPDATE FROM ISFAEL

During UN Secretary General Ban Ki-moon's visit to Israel last October, he was treated to a demo of a machine the Israeli government has given to Bedouin families to convert organic waste into clean biogas for cooking, heating and lighting, as well as organic liquid crop fertilizer.
