They escape the camp and survive the treacherous journey to freedom, but become separated and each is convinced that the other has died.

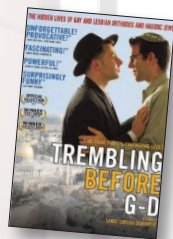


February 11 – Hava Nagila

February 25 – Trembling Before God
