Message from **Rabbi Haaz**



I remember having coffee with a prominent Jewish marketing executive 16 months ago to draw on his perspective on the American Jewish community. He remarked that, in order for synagogue life to be relevant, synagogues need to pursue ‘total disruption.’ His words struck me at the time, and I was simultaneously terrified and intrigued. Recently, I have found myself reflecting on those words again because the disruption that I imagined at that time was nothing compared to the disruption of this past year and the experience of bringing a synagogue through the COVID-19 pandemic. How could we, sitting in that café, have guessed what was in store: High Holy Day “Mosaics,” virtual Passover Seders, weddings postponed, Bar/Bat Mitzvah guests limited, children wearing masks in preschool, and months and months of online prayer services, education classes, and social gatherings. Yet, through all of these experiences, we witnessed the resilience and recreation of Jewish ritual and practice.

While our Jewish souls were, in some ways, impoverished by not being able to gather physically, they were, in other ways, enriched by new expressions of our sacred tradition. I look forward to engaging in deep and meaningful conversation with you about what learned expressions of Judaism from the pandemic should remain or be incorporated into our regular synagogue practice. Har Zion has been, and will continue to be, among the synagogues leading the way forward for American Jewry, and your voices, reflections, and suggestions will help make this so.

In the meantime, please get excited about an incredible year to come. More and more congregants are coming onto our campus each week, we have strong enrollment in our camp and schools, and we are hopeful that the national and global trends toward health will continue. Our excellent team of professional staff and committed lay leaders has been working tirelessly to plan a year that inspires and connects people in meaningful ways. We will, undoubtedly, still be wearing our masks and maintaining our safety protocols for months to come, but we will absolutely find great blessing in all the ways in which we will soon be together. Thank you for continuing your Jewish journey with me and all of your friends at Har Zion; we have an incredible path to walk together as we emerge, step-by-step, from the pandemic and bring forward all that we have learned.

Message from Our Co-Presidents, Arthur Berkowitz and Dorene Karasick

We will be completing our terms as Co-Presidents, and along with the existing Officer corps, will be turning over the leadership of HZT to a new group of Officers on June 12. We want to take this opportunity to thank our congregants, clergy, and senior and support staff, for the honor of serving the Har Zion Temple community.



Our synagogue is in a very good place, and rebounding strongly from the past year’s COVID challenges. From a financial standpoint, due to the successful procurement of both PPP and ERTC funds, along with the generosity of our membership, we are in a stable position, and pleased to announce that there will be NO membership dues increase for the coming year.

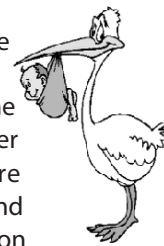

Message from Dr. Michael Schatz, JFGRS Director of Curriculum and Instruction

As we have moved through the spring during this pandemic year, we have tried to keep up our Jewish calendar through programming in the school. We devoted much of our time to preparing for Pesach and the Keiser-Wilf Model Seder, held this year on Zoom. In some classes where holidays are a major feature of curriculum, the children continued their learning about Pesach and its observances and celebrations. All of our Elementary school classes prepared for the songs and *brachot* of the Seder, building on skills learned in the past. This effort paid off in the participation in our Model Seder, as well as in your home Sedarim! Each child took home a Seder Goody Bag, containing various items needed, such as grape juice, matzah and a kiddush cup. We also sent home activity sheets and an art project – to make Ten Plagues finger puppets!

After our Pesach break, we turn our attention to celebrating Israel's Independence Day, Yom Ha'atzmaut. The Middle School participated in an Israel-themed Escape Room with a company called "Bagels and Locks." The Elementary School enjoyed an interactive performance celebrating Israel with The Bible Players. This duo who are Philadelphia natives and graduates of Akiba Hebrew Academy, bring humor and participation to their teaching, and all of the students were able to join in on Zoom.

As we wind down the school year, we are anticipating a full return to normal in-person Religious School in the fall. Registration is well underway, and thanks to a generous gift from the Kramer Family, tuition is even more affordable to all of our Har Zion Temple families. We are hopeful to take what we learned about small group instruction for Hebrew, and utilizing technology to enhance all of our curriculum, as we return to being a community all together in our spacious building.
