Extending our celebration of Jewish Music Season, Hazzan Vogel will present an Instrumental Shabbat Service at 6 PM with organ, accompanied by Dr. Ralph Selig in the Main Sanctuary.

*Dr. Selig is a Professor at the Abraham Geiger Institute in Berlin, Germany. Dr. Selig will also present some brief remarks on the history of the organ in Jewish worship. He is an expert in German Jewish choral music and teaches the next generation of Rabbis and Cantors in Germany. In addition to his comments, Dr. Selig will also present some special artifacts of the German Jewish culture such as original manuscripts of music and prayer books. The service will feature mostly familiar melodies along with selections of a primarily lost German Jewish musical tradition.*

## INNOVATION UPDATE FROM ISRAEL IDEAS Machines about to Revolutionize the Way Food is Prepared

Eshchar Ben-Shitrit grew up on a kibbutz where his mother ran the dairy farm. He observed the strong bond between cows and their calves, and this memory triggered something in him when he became a father four years ago. "When my first son was born I felt it was not possible to eat meat anymore. I felt I'd be eating someone else's child," said Ben-Shitrit. "I got obsessed with finding a solution for people who enjoy meat, like me, but don't want to eat animals." Using professional expertise honed at printing companies including HP Indigo and Highcon, Ben-Shitrit quit his job earlier this year and founded Jet-Eat. Working with food scientists, he's developing 3D printing technologies to produce plant-based "beef" with the approximate appearance, texture and mouth feel of cattle meat.


