INNOVATION UPDATE FROM  ISRAEL IDEAS
Is Your Water Safe To Drink?

The Israeli company, Lishtot, has an inexpensive device that can tell if your water is drinkable – in about two seconds. “In the US and Canada, there are about 20 boiled-water notices every day,” says Netanel Raisch, CEO of Israeli company Lishtot. “There are millions of people where the quality of their drinking water is uncertain. Soon there may be a quick-test solution: an inexpensive, reusable device that takes about two seconds to tell you if the water is pure or contaminated. Normally, boil-water alerts are in effect for 36 hours because it takes 24 hours to detect E. coli – the main cause for alerts. We bridge that 36-hour gap in two seconds,” says Raisch. Lishtot’s technology can detect bacteria, heavy metals and organic pesticides based on changes in the water’s electronic properties. By mid-2016, Lishtot plans to introduce the first of its three products – a straw sized pocket device retailing for less than \$50. 
